<u>नये युग में आर्य समाज</u> आचार्य डॉ. उमेश यादव

जब हम विचार करते हैं कि विश्वभर में स्वदेश, स्वराष्ट्र, स्वभाषा, स्ववस्तु, स्वसंस्कृति और स्वसंस्कारों पर स्वाभिमान की ज्ञान-ज्योति प्रदीप्त कर सकने में आर्य समाज इतना क्यों समर्थ हो सका, अन्य मतमतान्तर के अनुयायियों में वह जोर क्यों नहीं उभरा प्रतीत होता है तो इसका एक ही उत्तर है महर्षि दयानन्द का सार्वभौमिक चिन्तन व शुद्ध वैदिक विचार । राष्ट्रोन्नति के लिये निम्न विचार अपेक्षित है -

राजनीति, राष्ट्रनीति, राष्ट्रचरित्र और राजधर्म- ये चारों शब्द एक राष्ट्र की समुन्नति के लिये आवश्यक एवं व्यावहारिक हैं।

राजनीति- अर्थात् राज के लिये आवश्यक नीतियों का सत्प्रयोग हेतु जो अनुशासन की विधा है; वही राजनीति है । यह देश की छोटी से बड़ी इकाई तक को अनुशासन प्रदान करने की एक मजबूत पद्धति है । इसका जब दुरुपयोग होने लगता है तब हम विचार करने के लिये विवश होने लगते हैं कि दोष कहाँ आया । यद्यपि राजनीति अपने आप में एक शुद्ध पद्धति है पर नैतिकता के पतन से यह राजनीति न रहकर छल, कपट, धोखा,

अमीरी-गरीबी, छुवाछूत, ऊँच-नीच आदि का भेदभाव जैसे संक्रमित विचारों का समावेश इसमें आ जाये तो यह "राजनीति" दूषित हो जाती है और ओछी-ओछी नीतियों व विचारों का शिकार होकर देश के लिये अनेक हानियाँ पहुँचाने लगती है। राजनीति की ऐसी अवस्था में अपना शासन वा सरकार चलाना ही उद्देश्य रह जाता है चाहे इसके लिये कोई भी छल-कपट ही क्यों न करना पड़े । अतः हमें राजनीति को राष्ट्रनीति के स्तर पर लाकर सोचना होगा । हमें राष्ट्रनीति की प्रधानता देनी होगी ।

राष्ट्रनीति- राष्ट्रनीति शब्द अपने आप में एक व्यापक अर्थ सिमटे हुये है। यह शब्द हमें विशाल राष्ट्र की उन्नित की ओर ध्यानाकर्षित करता है। जब हम ऐसा विचार करते हैं कि हमें वह कार्य करना है जिससे राष्ट्र का मान, उसकी सुरक्षा, सौन्दर्य, स्वाभिमान और सार्वभौमिक विकास हो सके तब राष्ट्रोन्नित सिद्ध होती है। राष्ट्र की सीमा में रहने वाली प्रजा का सुख शिक्षा, संस्कार, नैतिकता, आवश्यकता, न्याय आदि की पूर्ति इसमें निहित है। इसके लिये राष्ट्र में होने वाली सारी व्यवस्थायें उपयुक्त हो; ऐसा विचार जब आयेगा तब हम निष्पक्ष होकर उसे क्रियान्वित करने के लिये जो भी कार्य करेंगे वह राष्ट्रोन्नित का होगा। यहाँ किसी भी संकीर्णता की गुँजायश नहीं है। सबके प्रति उदारभाव से व्यवहार करते हुये समानता का व्यवहार करना, "सबकी उन्नित में अपनी उन्नित" (आर्य समाज का ९वाँ नियम) समझकर ही चलना उद्देश्य होगा। यहीं से राष्ट्रीय चरित्र की स्थापना होगी।

राष्ट्रचिरत्र- राष्ट्रचिरित्र का भाव भी राष्ट्रोन्नित का प्रबल सहायक है। चिरित्र का विकास उत्तम संस्कारों से होता है। नैतिक मूल्यों के विकास की बात महर्षि दयानन्द ने सत्यार्थ प्रकाश के दूसरे और तीसरे समुल्लास में विस्तार से कहा। इसके चौथा समुल्लास में भी सद् गृहस्थ के संतितिनिर्माण व पारस्परिक संबन्धों को उभारते हुये सबके संज्ञान में जो आवश्यक शिक्षा दी गयी है, नैतिक मूल्यों के विकास के लिये अत्यन्त महत्त्वपूर्ण है। अपनी संतान को हम न केवल स्वयं के लिये अपितु उन्हें

परिवार, समाज व राष्ट्र के लिये जिम्मेवार होने के लिये तैयार करने की

प्रेरणा प्राप्त है। इस भाव को आर्य समाज के ६ठे नियम में भी उभारा "संसार का उपकार करना इस समाज का मुख्य उद्देश्य है अर्थात् सबकी
शारीरिक, सामाजिक और आत्मिक उन्नित करना।" धार्मिक, विद्वान् और
प्रशस्त माता-पिता और आचार्य ही अपनी संतित को नैतिकता की इस
उच्चाई तक पहुँचाने में सफल हो सकेंगे। "मातृमान् पितृमान् आचार्यवान्
पुरुषो वेद" शतपथ ब्राहमण का यह वाक्य कितना सार्थक है। योग्य व
श्रेष्ठ संतान तो अपने माता-पिता और आचार्य की सार्वभौमिक शिक्षाओं के
लिये गौरवान्वित होती है, वही संतान राष्ट्र की भी गौरव बन सकेगी।
इसके लिये हम महर्षि दयानन्द प्रणीत सत्यार्थप्रकाश के ६ठे समुल्लास में
वर्णित "राजधर्म" पर विचार करना होगा जो राष्ट्र के समुचित विकास के
लिये सही मार्गदर्शन है।

राजधर्म- राज धर्म अर्थात् राज-व्यवस्था में यथोचित कार्यनीति/ नियम/
कर्तिव्य व कानून । यहाँ महर्षि दयानन्द द्वारा दिये मार्गदर्शन पर जब
हम विचार करते हैं जो इसमें राजव्यवस्था में कोई छल-कपट, अन्याय,
अत्याचार, अभाव की समस्या ही नहीं रह जाती है । राजा-प्रजा का परस्पर
श्रेष्ठ सहयोगात्मक सम्बन्ध निष्पक्षभाव से मुखरित हो पाया है । यहाँ धर्म
का तात्पर्य मत-मतान्तर से नहीं है अपितु सत्य नियम व कार्य (
राइटियस ऐक्शन) से है । सेक्यूलर शब्द से इसे नहीं जोड़ा जा सकता ।
सेक्यूलर शब्द का अर्थ "मतनिर्पक्ष" है जिसका मतलब है कि सभी प्रकार
के मत/मजहब वाले विना भेदभाव राष्ट्र में रहें तथा सरकार भी उनके साथ
विना भेदभाव के व्यवहार करे; सबकी सुखोन्नित का ख्याल हो । इसे हम
धर्मनिर्पक्ष नहीं कह सकते । बात समझें- धर्म+नि:+अपेक्ष अर्थात् धर्म की

अपेक्षा/आवश्यकता न होना । धर्म का अर्थ है कि जो कार्य/व्यवहार सबके

द्वारा समानरुप से धारण कर लिया जाये जिसमें कोई रुकावट न हो । " धर्मो धार्यते सर्वै:, धारयति सर्वान् वा समानरुपेण-इति"। स्पष्ट है कि यहाँ धर्म हिन्दु-मुसलमान, सिख, इसाई आदि के मत-मतान्तर की बात नहीं कही जा रही है । रेलिजन की बात नहीं बल्कि राइटियस ऐक्शन की बात हो रही है । मुस्लिम मत हिन्दु को मानने में और मुसलिम को हिन्दु-मत मानने में कहीं रुकावट आती है तो स्पष्ट ही यह धर्म कोटि में नहीं आता विक्कि मतमतान्तर के दायरे में ही समझा जायेगा । अत: राजधर्म में संकुचित विचार नहीं है अपितु राष्ट्र की जनता के सुख आदि मानवाधिकार को यथार्थ रुप देने के लिये व्यावहारिक संविधान है । राजधर्म की कुछ विशेषताओं का दिग्दर्शन यहाँ करते हैं-

राजधर्म की विशेषतायें- राजधर्म का यदि हम पालन नैतिकता को प्रधान मानकर राष्ट्र में करते हैं तो ही हमारा राष्ट्र एक उच्च स्तरीय चिरत्र वाला बन सकेगा। कभी आर्यावर्त्त इस गौरव को प्राप्त था, तभी तो यह घोषणा की गयी थी - एतद्देश प्रस्तस्य सकाशादग्रजजन्मनः। स्वं स्वं चिरत्रं शिक्षेरन् पृथिव्यां सर्व मानवाः। मनुस्मृति अर्थात् इस देश के अग्रज ऋषि-मुनियों-आचार्यों के सम्पर्क में आकर धरती के सभी मानव अपने-अपने चिरत्र को शिक्षित कर समुन्नत करें। आज देश में बढ़ता दुराचार, अन्याय, शोषण, व्यभिचार, कन्याभूण हत्या, अपहरण, बलात्कार जैसे जघन्य पापों को देखकर मानसिक पीड़ा होती है। ऐसा क्यों? निःसंदेह नैतिकता का पतन ही है। मानवीय उत्तम संस्कारों की कमी ही है। राजा व प्रजा में पारस्परिक तालमेल व विश्वास नहीं होने से ये सारी अराजकतायें सम्भव हैं जो हो रही हैं। इसके निराकरण के लिये हमें महर्षि दयानन्द द्वारा लिखित राजधर्म को जानना और उसे व्यवस्था में लाना नितान्त सहायक होगा।
