10 Principles of Arya Samaj

Meaning

The desire of greed is very strong, extensive and pervades in everything. It has golden hair, (it is very tempting). Therefore a person should say good bye from distance.

Contemplation

The Vedic concept, wealth is not condemned. A devotee of the Vedas prays to God to shower His blessing of wealth upon him. In the words of Yajur Veda – may we become the master of wealth _vyam syam patyo ryinam. It is paramount that wealth is not concentrated in society in few hands. It is desired that everyone in society has adequate share of wealth according to their basic needs. To hoard wealth by snatching it from others is merely greed. The tendency of snatching others wealth is born from the vicious notion of greed which has no limit.

In the words of this mantra the devilish notion of greed is unimaginably vast. The sky is its limit and it spreads in all directions. As soon as we nurture this notion in our mind, it makes us restless, it is very tempting. It is the enemy of contentment and without contentment no one can attain peace of mind. It generates selfishness and no compassion for others. The person becomes heartless.

Misers and greedy people ignore deprived and destitute relatives. It has golden hair. A greedy person cannot spare one golden hair for others but on the contrary they wish to hoard all gold. We are used to seeing its attractive side but the other hidden side is its selfishness, greed and ungenerous tendencies which is described in the words of the mantra as **nirriti**. It generates disparity in society and disparity generates anger and desperation. It is the duty of the people who run the government of any country to make sure that the wealth is properly distributed throughout the nation. Uneven distribution of wealth in society generates crime, disturbance, violence and discontent..

Therefore the mantra instructs us that not to nourish the notions of selfishness, greed and lack of ungenerosity in our minds and stay far away from ungenerous notions.

ईश्वर और जीव को पृथक्-पृथक् समझकर हमें यह भी समझना होगा कि जीव और ईश्वर की ईच्छा भिन्न-भिन्न है। जीव शरीर में रहकर सांसारिक सुख, साधन, आराम आदि की ईच्छा करता है और साथ ही मुक्ति गत् आनन्द की भी पर ईश्वर सब जीवों के जन्म-जन्मान्तर के भोग चक्र को पूरा करने के लिये सृष्टि के प्रारम्भ में वेद-ज्ञान प्रकट करने का ईक्षण करता है। सृष्टि उत्पन्न करना, सम्भालना, चलाना, कर्मानुसार सब जीवों को पाप-पुण्य जनक दु:ख-सुख का फल निर्धारण करना आदि सब ईश्वर के ईक्षण में सम्मिलित है। यह ईश्वर का मुख्य कार्य है।

आगे हम थोड़ा वेद-विषय भी समझते हैं। वेद का प्रकाश कब और कैसे हुआ ? यह प्रश्न निम्न विवरण से स्पष्ट हो जायेगा। प्रथम सृष्टि के आदि में ऋग्वेद अग्नि ऋषि, यजुर्वेद वायु ऋषि, सामवेद आदित्य ऋषि और अथर्ववेद अँगिरा ऋषि के पवित्र आत्मा में परमात्मा द्वारा प्रकाशित किया गया। शतपथ ब्राहमण का यह प्रमाण देखें- " अग्नेर्वा ऋग्वेदो जायते वायोर्यजुर्वेद: स्प्रात्सामवेद:" यहाँ आदित्य ऋषि को सूर्य शब्द से प्रकट किया गया है क्योंकि आदित्य ऋषि को कहीं-कहीं सूर्य वा रिव शब्द से भी वैदिक साहित्यों में बताया गया है। कालान्तर में आदित्य, सूर्य और रिव पर्यायवाची शब्द माने गये हैं। अँगिरा ऋषि को अथर्ववेद का ज्ञान मिला। यह अर्थ यहाँ प्रकरण से निकाला गया है। कालान्तर में इन्हीं चार ऋषियों से चारों वेदों का ज्ञान बहमा ऋषि ने ग्रहण किया और इस प्रकार वेद का ज्ञान संसार भर में फैला। कदाचित इसी कारण ब्रह्मा ऋषि को चतुर्भुज कहा जाने लगा जो आलाँकारिक है। भुज शब्द यहाँ वेद के लिये प्रयुक्त है। मनुस्मृति का यह प्रमाण देखें- "अग्निवायुरविभ्यस्तु त्रयं ब्रह्म सनातनम्। दुदोह यज्ञसिद्ध्यर्थमृग्यजु:

सामलक्षणम्" ॥ अथार्त् ब्रहमा ऋषि ने सनातन वेद-ज्ञान को क्रमश: अग्नि ऋषि से ऋग्वेद, वायु से यजुर्वेद, रवि (आदित्य) से सामवेद और आँगिरा से अथर्वेद जाना ।

यहाँ यह विचारणीय होगा कि सृष्टि के आदि में (लगभग १९६८०९०५०० वर्ष पूर्व-देखें ऋग्वेदादि भाष्य भूमिका-वेदोत्पत्ति-प्रकरण-महर्षि दयानन्द-कृत) जब मनुष्य बने तो सब मनुष्यों में श्रेष्ठतम पिवत्र आत्मायें ईश्वर के ज्ञान में अग्नि, वायु, आदित्य और अँगिरा ये चार ऋषिगण ही माने गये । तभी ईश्वर ने कृपाकर इन्हीं चारों को उनकी पिवत्र आत्मा में क्रमशः ये चार वेद ऋग्, यजुः, साम और अथर्व एक ही साथ प्रकाशित किये । वही परमात्मा / ईश्वर सब को उत्पन्न करके सृष्टि समेत सबको ही धारण भी कर रहा है । इस प्रकार परमात्मा ही सम्पूर्ण सृष्टि का स्वामी है । वेद स्वयं इसका प्रमाण है । यस्माद्दचो अपातक्षन् यजुर्यस्मादपाकषन् ।

सामानि यस्य लोमान्यथर्वागिँरसो मुखं स्कम्भं तं ब्रूहि कतमः स्विदेव सः ॥ अथर्ववेद-१०.२३.४.२०

इस मंत्र का सामान्य अर्थ है कि जिस परमात्मा से ऋग्वेद, यजुर्वेद, सामवेद और अथर्ववेद प्रकाशित हुये, वह परमात्मा कौन सा देव है ? इसका उत्तर यजुर्वेद के इस मंत्र में निहित है । जो सबको उत्पन्न कर धारण कर रहा है वह देव ही परमात्मा है । "स्वयम्भूर्याथातथ्यतोऽर्थान् व्यदधाच्छाश्वतीभ्यः समाभ्यः "॥ यजु. ४०/८ महर्षि दयानन्द ने इसका अर्थ इस प्रकार किया-

" जो स्वयंभू सर्वव्यापक शुद्ध, निराकार परमेश्वर है, वह सनातन जीव रूप प्रजा के कल्यानार्थ यथावत् रीतिपूर्वक वेद द्वारा सब विद्याओं का उपदेश करता है ।"-देखें-स.प्र. स.समु.-ऋषि दयानन्द कृत.। इससे यह स्पष्ट है कि ईश्वर ही सम्पूर्ण सृष्टि और सब वेद ज्ञान का मूल है।

९ वाँ सँस्कार- कर्णवेध आचार्य डॉ. उमेश यादव

कर्णवेधो वर्ष तृतीये पँचमे वा-पा. गृहयसूत्र १/१७-यह सँस्कार आमतौर पर तीसरे अथवा पाँचवे वर्ष में किया जाना प्रामाणित है। कान या नाक छेदने का यह उपयुक्त समय है। इस समय तक इन अँगों का छेदव्य स्थान अनुकूल हो जाता है। यह सँस्कार भी लिँग-भेद के दायरे में नहीं है। वालक हो या वालिका दोनों के लिये समान रुप से स्वीकृत है। यह अलग बात है कि आजकल केवल लड़कियाँ ही नाक-कान छिदवाती हैं। पुराने काल में लड़कों के लिये भी यह काफी प्रचलन था जो प्रमाण के अनुकूल था पर आज इसका लड़कों के लिये कम हो गया है। कहीं-कहीं आज भी लड़कों के लिये कान में कुँडल डालने का रिवाज है। कान के कुँडल तो श्री राम तथा श्री कृष्ण जी के लिये अत्यन्त प्रसिद्ध है कि उनके कर्ण-कुँडल अत्यन्त शोभायमान होते थे।

यद्यपि पुराने शास्त्रों में नासिका-वेध नहीं लिखा है तथापि नारियों के नाक-छेदन को समझते हुये महर्षि दयानन्द ने इसी सँस्कार के अन्तर्गत् नासिका-वेध को भी स्वीकारा है। प्राय: नारियाँ कान और नाक दोनों में आभूषण डालती हैं। ऐसा स्वीकार कर इन्होंने नारी का सम्मान बढ़ाया है। "कर्णवेधो वर्ष तृतीये पँचमे वा" इस पारस्कर गृहसूत्रीय प्रमाण का अर्थ महर्षि ने इस प्रकार किया-"कर्ण वा नासिका के वेध का समय जन्म के तीसरे या पाँचवें वर्ष का है" देखें -सँ.वि. द्वितीय सँस्करण-कर्ण-वेध सँस्कार-प्रकरण। अतः हमें इसे स्वीकारने में कोई आपत्ति नहीं है। यह तो केवल अलँकार धारण करने हेतु है जो बालक वा बालिका दोनों को समान अधिकार है: अपनी मनपसन्द वे चाहे नाक-कान जो भी वेधवाना चाहें: इसमें कोई आपत्ति नहीं है।

सँस्कार के दिन- जिस दिन कर्ण वा नासिका वेधन की क्रिया करनी है, वच्चे को

स्नान करा शुद्ध वस्त्रालँकार धारण करावें और यज्ञशाला में लाकर विधिवत् सँस्कार करें । वच्चे को वेधन-काल में उसका मन रिझाये रखने के लिये कुछ अच्छी चीज खाने के लिये और खेलने के लिये कोई आकर्षक खेलौना भी दें ।

सँस्कार-प्रयोजन- "रक्षाभूषणिनिमित्तं बालस्य कर्णौ बिध्येते"-सुश्रुत-सूत्रस्थान-१६/१
अर्थात् रक्षा तथा आभूषण के लिये यह सँस्कार है। दोनों कान या नासिका वेध
इन दो कारणों से ही किया जाता है। रक्षा या आभूषण। यह व्यवहार लड़का या
लड़की दोनों पर लागू होता है। लड़कियाँ नाक-कान दोनों में आभूषण डालती हैं
पर लड़के कहीं-कहीं केवल कान में ही कुँडल डालते हैं। रक्षा तो दोनों के वेधन में
है। वस्तुत: कर्ण वेध से एक ऐसा नस का वेधन होता है जिसका सम्बन्ध
आन्त्रवृद्धि (हरनिया) दोष को रोकने में सहायक है। इससे अँड-वृद्धि दोष भी
नष्ट होता है। इस प्रकार पुँसत्व नष्ट करने वाले रोगों से रक्षा होती है क्योंकि
कर्णेन्द्रियों का सम्बन्ध सीधा वीर्यवाहिनी नाड़ियों से है। इसके लिये कुशल वैद्य
या अनुभवी सुनार की आवश्यकता है जो कर्ण वा नासिका वेधन में प्रवीण हो;
जिसे अच्छी तरह कर्ण या नासिका स्थानीय नसों का सम्यग् ज्ञान हो, वही इस
कार्य को करने का सही अधिकारी है। निम्न यजुर्वेदीय मन्त्रों को पढ़कर विद्वान्
आचार्य के पौरोहित्य में और कुशल वैद्य या अनुभवी सुनार से वेधन-कार्य करावें
। ये मंत्र इस प्रकार हैं।

ओ३म् भद्रं कर्णभि:शृणुयाम देवा भद्रं पश्येमाक्षभिर्यजत्राः । स्थिरैरँगैस्तुष्टुवाँ सस्तनुभिर्व्यशेमहि देवहितं यदाह्ः ॥ यजु. २५/२१ -

इससे दायाँ कर्ण या नासिका वेधें । और ओ३म् वक्ष्यन्ती वेदागनीगन्ति कर्णं प्रियं सखायं परिषस्वजाता । योषैव शिँक्ते वितताधि धन्वँज्या इयं समने पारयन्ति ॥ यजु. २९/४० - इससे बायाँ कर्ण या नासिका वेधें । वही कुशल वैद्य उन छिद्रों में शलाका डाल दे और उचित औषधि लगा दे कि वे छिद्र पके नहीं; शीघ्र अच्छे हो जाये । यहाँ ऋषि कश्यप के ये दो श्लोक भी यही पुष्ट करते हैं कि योग्य वैद्य का चयन बहुत आवश्यक है वरणा वेधित कर्ण वा नासिका में पाक आने से घाव बनने का डर बना रहेगा । ऋषि कश्यप के सन्दर्भित श्लोक इस प्रकार हैं-

- १. कदा वेध्यं कथं वेध्यं कुत्र वेध्यं कथं व्यधः । हितोऽहितोऽत्यः कश्च तत्राज्ञः किं प्रपत्स्यते ॥
 भावार्थ- नाक या कान कब, कैसे, कहाँ वींधें, इसका हानि-लाभ क्या है, यह सब एक कुशल वैदय ही समझेगा । कोई अज्ञानी क्या समझेगा ?
- २. तस्माद् भिषक् सकुशलः कर्णं विध्येत् विचक्षणः । शिशोः हर्षप्रमत्तस्य धर्मकामार्थसिद्धये ॥

भावार्थ- इस कारण इस कार्य को करने हेतु कुशल वैद्य ही चुने अथवा कोई अनुभवी सुनार जो वेधव्य स्थानों के नसों को अच्छी तरह जानता हो और लगाने वाली आवश्यक औषधि को जानता तथा साथ रखता भी हो । इस श्लोक का अन्तिम चरण का भाव संतान पर बहुत ही उत्तम सँस्कार डालता है । उसकी प्रसन्नता, स्वास्थ्य और जीवन भर धर्म, अर्थ, काम और मोक्ष की सिद्धि के मार्ग पर चलता रहे ।

सँस्कार गत् पठनीय प्रस्तुत यजुर्वेदीय मंत्रों का भाव भी हमें जानना चाहिये। कानों से भद्र सुनें, कानों में प्रियता यानि मिठास भरें, आँखें वस में रहकर भद्र देखें, इस प्रकार सारे आँग स्वस्थ रह अच्छी तरह कार्य करें और सदैव देवहित में ही सिक्रिय रहें। इस प्रकार संतान पर उत्तम व्यावहारिक सँस्कार डालते हुये उन्हें उत्तम चरित्र का स्वामी बनाना उद्देश्य है। भविष्य में वे कामाशक्ति पर काबू रख अँडवृद्धि आदि दोष से बचकर निरोग रहें -ऐसा प्रस्तुत यजुर्वेदीय दूसरे मंत्र का अभिप्राय है।
